

Grading criteria MT7050

Examination consists of two parts, a written exam (3 hp) and a project part consisting of 4 projects (4.5 hp). The written exam and each project are graded on a scale of 0 to 100 points. In addition, project 4 requires taking an active part in an oral presentation.

A passing grade for the course requires a minimum of 50 points on the written exam and ALL projects. The total score (from 0 to 100 points) of the course is given by the following formula:

Total score = (Written exam score) $\times$ 40% + (mean score of proj. 1, 2 and 3) $\times$ 36% + (proj. 4 score) $\times$ 24%

In words, the written exam, first 3 projects and the 4th project contribute 40%, 36% and 24% of the total score, respectively. Given the total score, the final grade for the course are A (≥ 90 points), B (≥ 80 points), C (≥ 70 points), D (≥ 60 points), E (≥ 50 points), Fx and F. A late submitted project will result in a 15 points deduction from the 100 points maximally obtainable from a project.

Late submitted project reports will receive a 7-point deduction. If one fails a project (i.e., with score < 50 points), only one revised report is allowed to be re-submitted. A revised report will have a total 15 + 7 points deductions from the 100 points maximally obtainable from a project.

For a partially completed project part, scores on individual project are only valid until the last day of the semester VT26.
